

**Household Size-Income Scale for the CACFP – Family Day Care Home Providers**

**Effective July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019**

Listed below are the USDA Income Guidelines to determine eligibility by the income information reported on the completed Household Size-Income Statements for provider’s own children, children in care at the higher Tier I rates, or to qualify the family day home provider for Tier 1 rates.
