- 6-7 credits in humanities (HIS 112 and HIS 121 or LAN101 and LAN111)
- 8 credits in natural sciences (lecture and lab)
- 6 credits in mathematics (MAT 106 and MAT 120 or MAT 260)
- 9 credits in social sciences (HUD 210, EDU 236, elective)
- 3 credits in fine arts (ART105 or 106)
- 3 credits in sustainable development (SDE100)
- 3 in credits oral communications (COM 100) with a B or better
- 3 credits in general education requirements (EDU 100)
- 6 credits in English (ENG 101, ENG 102)
- 15 credits in early childhood (EDU250, EDU256, EDU 237, EDU 238, and EDU 201),

Student must have a minimum grade point average of 2.85 in completed major coursework, and

Student must demonstrate the fulfillment of these requirements of CMN’s Teacher Education Department:

Students must pass one of the following Basic Skills tests:

- Pass PRAXIS CORE Basic Skills test (Reading - 156, Writing - 162, Math - 150) OR

- Pass ACT (Score of 23 with minimum sub-scores of 20 on English, Math and Reading) OR
- Pass SAT (Minimum Sub-scores of 520 on Math, 510 on Critical Reading and 480 on Writing)

OR

Students must complete one of the following in Mathematics:

- Pass a Basic Skills test in Math
- OR
- Have a minimum GPA of 3.0 in either MAT 104/MAT 106

AND

Students must complete one of the following in Reading and Writing:

- Pass a Basic Skills Test in Reading and Writing OR
- Have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 in ENG 100/ENG 101 AND ENG 102 OR
- Combination of one passing score on reading or writing on a Basic Skills Test AND a minimum GPA of 3.0 in one of the English Courses: ENG 100/ENG 101 OR ENG 102

Submit documentation of a minimum of 30 hours of field experience in educational settings,

Submit the Teacher Education Program Application for Admission on or before the application deadline (October 15/March 15).
