1. Providers may be reimbursed for:

- 28 grams or ½ of a whole grain English Muffin topped with ½ ounce (1 T) of tomato sauce, 2 ounces mozzarella cheese and ½ ounce of sauteed ground beef; ½ c. lettuce salad; ½ c mandarin oranges; and 1 cup of 1% milk for dinner for a child who is 6 years old.
